PARK DIRECTOR UPDATE by Max Gibbs



This has been, for those of us who really live where there is a winter, one of the best we have ever had!

I know that without a lot of snow our members worry about the lake being full of water. The lake in the middle of March was 3" from overflowing the wier. We haven't even had our April showers...which bring May flowers!

The Federal Government has mandated that a lift be installed at our swimming pools to help handicapped members have access to the pools. This new law affects every hotel, motel and campground in the United States. We have ordered our lifts, and when they arrive our staff will install them.

The Bylaws allow the Board to pass an Assessment to pay for government mandated expenses, but due to the fact that we have managed our money well, this will not be necessary. The cost of the lifts will be taken from our contingency account, which was set up in 1997, and money is placed in this account to take care of unbudgeted items. Your Sandy Pines has been saving money, and we will use these funds, instead of assessing our members.

The new power poles have been installed in the Park. Wolverine Power has completed this project. They will also take care of landscaping, road repairs and grading the areas affected. This will take place during April and May. Some of the work can only be completed when the weather changes to summer.

Please put June 9th on your calendar for the Open House at the new golf clubhouse.

Members and Associate Members will need to present their mag cards to play free golf. Make sure that you have yours available when you go to the golf course.

Boat Stakes and Water Stickers:

We must have an up to date state boat registration by June 1st. After June 1st, your boat stake will be opened up for someone on our boat stake waiting list. You can email a copy to memberservice@sandypines.com or fax a copy to 616-896-7409.

Mailbox Renters:

Before you head back to Sandy Pines you must turn in a temporary forward card to the Post Office. Make sure to list all names (including business names) that will be using your mailbox unit number. Remember to use the "2741" address. The Post Office does not inform the office when you are coming back, so be sure to let us know that you will be using your Sandy Pines box again.

2012 Flea Markets:

May 5, May 26, June 9, July 7, August 11, Sept. 1 and Oct. 6. Spaces are \$30 and can only be reserved online through the Member Web Access.

Charter Cable:

If you want to add extra services such as Internet or a digital box, call Charter's sales rep., Paul, at 269-214-4052 to make an appointment. He can give you the pricing for this year. Make sure that you stress that they use your home address for billing, not Sandy Pines address.

Pumpouts:

Single pumpouts are \$11 each on your scheduled day and must be scheduled online thru the Member Web access only. Emergency pumpouts are \$18. Emergencies are pumpouts done on Saturdays, not on your scheduled Phase day or same day service. No pumpouts are done after 3 pm, or on Sundays. Call backs after a tag has been punched, may result in an additional fee. Maintenance will start Saturday emergency pumpouts on May 5th.

Reminder: Please make sure that the pumpers have easy access to the holding tank valve. Fences, flower gardens or sheds should not be in the pumpers path or blocking the valve.

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Park Director Position

In case you did not read last month's Footprints, I wish to repeat the information concerning Max's upcoming retirement. He requested the Board accept his desire to retire from his position as Park Director, as of January 1, 2013. We, as a Board, agreed to honor his request.

Again, the rumors about the Board asking for his resignation, and that his replacement has been selected, have absolutely no truth behind them. We are proud of his leadership in making Sandy Pines the financially sound and diversified Park that it is. With his leadership, we have offered many amenities for our members, and continue to follow his impetus for the "greening" of the Park, and also by investing in improvements that will eventually pay for themselves.

The Board selected a local firm to help us locate a qualified replacement. This takes away any question of impropriety shown by the Board in the selection process. The person you need to contact, if interested in making an application for the position, is Casey Kuperus, Search Specialist, at Express Employment Professionals in Grand Rapids. ALL applications and initial interviews will be handled by him. He will do the background searches and provide the Board with a list of candidates he feels we should consider. I, as President of the Board, will appoint four Board members to this committee. The Board, as a whole, will select three members at large from the Park to sit on the committee. If you are looking for soft water, spot free dishes and no more iron stains in your Park Model, look no further. Simply stop by Park and Garden and sign up for an affordable "exchange tank". This tank will provide softened water to your site, and can be easily installed by you or the staff from Park and Garden.

The tank features standard garden hose fittings on the inlet and outlet valve of the tank. Set the tank on a level area next to your park model (you may want to strap or secure the tank so that it does not tip over). Disconnect your water supply at your trailer, and connect the male end to the inlet side of the tank. Next, connect an additional portable water hose (available at Park and Garden) from the outlet side

of the valve, back to your main water connection on your park model. It's that simple! You have all the luxuries of home away from home, why not have the feel of luxurious water!

The basic cost for one tank for the summer season is \$155. If you were to need a second tank, the cost would be \$95. Last year, 98% of our members only used one tank during the entire summer.

If you would like someone from Park and Garden to install your tank for you and come back and pick it up in the fall, that is an additional \$45. If you wish to install yourself, but have Park and Garden come and pick it up in the fall, that is an additional \$20.

Memorial Day Weekend Bass Fishing Contest

The Ranger Department will be hosting the annual Bass fishing contest. Opening day for Bass fishing is Saturday May 26th. Stop in or call the Ranger station at 616-896-9006 to enter. All participants must enter before the start of the contest (May 26th). Contest runs from May 26-28, and ends at 3 pm on May 28th. All entries must be weighed before 3 pm on May 28th. Contest winner will be determined by the weight of a single Bass. Entry fee is \$10 per entrant. First prize is \$100. Contestants must bring the Bass to the Ranger Station to be weighed. We support catch and release. Funds other than prize money will go toward the restocking of fish into the lake. Good Luck!

Golf cart registration stickers

When receiving your golf cart registration stickers this spring, please check your golf cart for site numbers on the front and rear of the golf cart. Your site numbers must be at least three inches in height in contrasting color of the golf cart and visible. Golf cart registration stickers were mailed to members that did not request to have them left at the Ranger Station. Please affix these golf cart registration stickers to your golf cart. These are to be placed on the right rear bumper or fender in a visible location. If you did not receive a golf cart registration sticker, one can be purchased at the Ranger Station or at the Member Services Office. Golf cart/moped stickers are \$10 each.

Allegan County Public Warning and Notification System

An outdoor warning siren is located in Phase 1 next to the Phase 1 beach.

Testing Procedures:

On the **4th Friday of each month at 11 am**. You should take this time to review your family emergency plans.

Emergency Activation Procedures:

The Severe Weather Siren is activated by the Allegan County 911 Dispatch Center. When the siren activates you will hear a three minute "steady" tone. At this time, you should seek shelter inside a sturdy structure and tune to local radio and television for further instructions.

Severe Weather:

Please take the time to discuss with your family your emergency plan for severe weather. Discuss where you plan to take shelter, where to meet after a storm (if separated), where to take shelter if out in the Park, and what to do if out on the lake. It is also advisable to designate a relative outside Sandy Pines to contact in the event of an emergency that all family members can contact.

A Severe Thunderstorm Watch:

This means that atmospheric conditions exist that could produce severe weather such as lightning, high winds, heavy rains, sleet and hail.

Severe Thunderstorm Warning:

This means that severe weather associated with thunderstorms is occurring such as high winds, lightning, hail, sleet and flooding.

Tornado Watch:

Atmospheric conditions exist that could permit the creation of a tornado.

Tornado Warning:

A tornado warning means that a tornado has been sighted or detected on radar. Tornadoes often, but not always, occur in conjunction with a severe thunderstorm.

Early warning preparation suggestions:

Be aware of changing weather conditions and weather forecasts. Listen to local radio and television stations. Purchase a NOAA weather radio. These commonly have a weather alert tone that activates when watches or threatening weather approaches. These will alert you to changing conditions and wake you as you sleep. Be prepared for electrical outages, with flashlights and spare batteries. Try to refrain from using candles which are a major cause of house fires. Remember that trees may block roadways after a storm, and to stay away from damaged electrical boxes and downed power lines.

Wow! The nice weather here at Sandy Pines continues, and many of you have been taking advantage of it by starting projects and doing clean ups. As a reminder, when doing your site clean ups this early, remember to check your site again at the beginning of June. We sometimes have strong spring storms that can ruin a clean up by then.

Also, when cleaning your leaves, they must be removed from the site and not blown into retired lots or green areas. If you are seen doing this, you will be required to remove the leaves and receive a violation. By removing the leaves, you will be hindering mosquitoes and other bugs from breeding.

I am not sure if I will be back on days before you read this or not, but I should be by the 15th of April for sure. I am currently still working Wednesday night through Sunday mornings, midnight to 10 am until I'm back on days.

Aquatics Update by Kim Day, Supervisor

We've had such a beautiful (and early) Spring, and Summer is right around the corner! We will be opening the pools again on Memorial Day weekend. We are changing the hours of the Water Park to 11 am to 9 pm Monday through Saturday (staying open between 5 pm - 6 pm) and 10 am - 5 pm Sunday. These hours will be during our recreation season, which begins June 18. The hours for off-season (before June 18th) are 1 pm - 9 pm Monday through Saturday (staying open between 5 pm - 6 pm) and 10 am - 5 pm on Sundays.

We are offering a Lifeguard Training Course on Saturday, June 9 through Friday, June 15. This Lifeguarding class will teach many important lifesaving and water safety skills such as patron surveillance, water entries, water rescue skills, and back boarding. Participants will also learn CPR, First Aid, and how to use an AED.

Prerequisites: All participants must be at least 15 years old by the last day of class. Participants must be able to swim 300 yards continuously with 100 yards being front crawl, 100 yards Breaststroke, and 100 yards either one. Participants must be able to tread water for two minutes, using only their legs. Participants must also be able to swim 20 yards, surface dive 10 feet, retrieve a 10 pound diving brick, return to the surface, and swim with the brick 20 yards back to the starting point in 1 minute and 40 seconds, or less. Certifications upon passing of this class is American Red Cross lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED valid for 2 years. We will be doing all our lifeguarding practice in the Indoor Pool and will be watching the video presentations and learning CPR in the Recreation Station. Here are the times for training course: Saturday meet at the Indoor Pool from Noon-3 pm, and we will complete the course prerequisites and discuss how the course is going to run. Monday - Friday 8 am-3 pm (more information about location each day will be given on the first day of class. Class times will vary, though they will not start before 8 am, nor will they end after 3 pm). The cost is \$180, which includes lifeguarding course, book, and certifications. - Please do not step in the putting line of another player when on the green to prevent indentation in the line of the intended putt.
- Please lay the flagstick down carefully so no damage is made to the putting green.
- Players should play without delay in the interest of all golfers on the course. When the play of a hole has been completed, players should immediately leave the putting green.
- Please avoid playing more than one ball on any hole.
- Please use receptacles provided for trash and do not discard cigarette butts on the course.
