

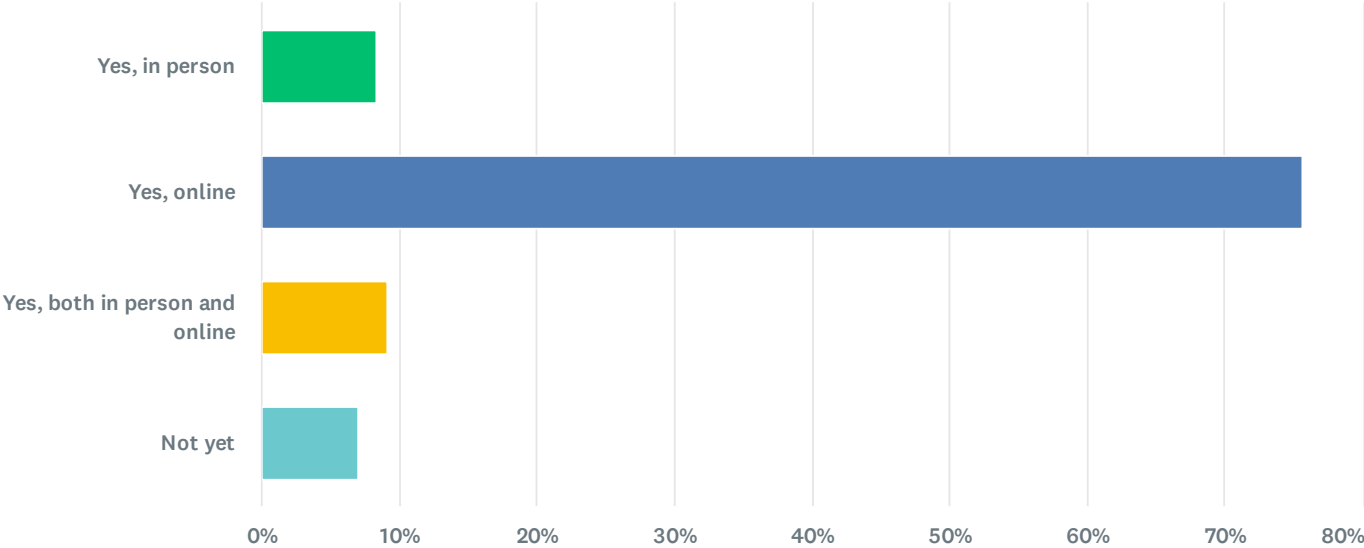

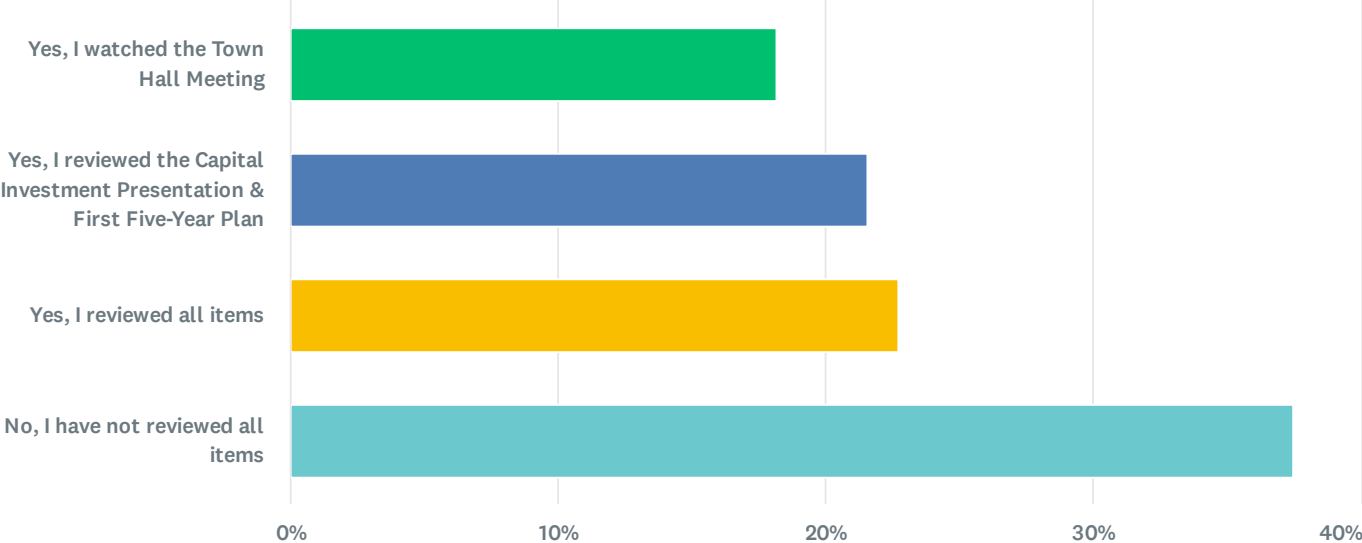

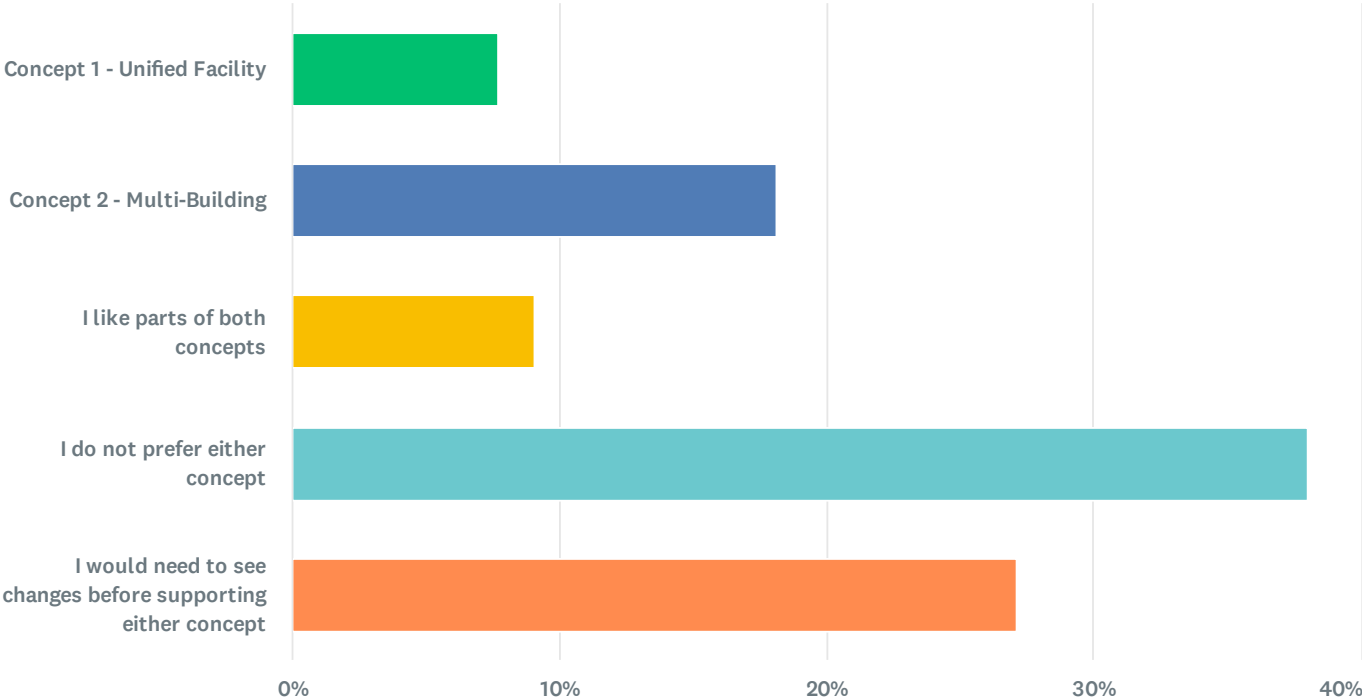

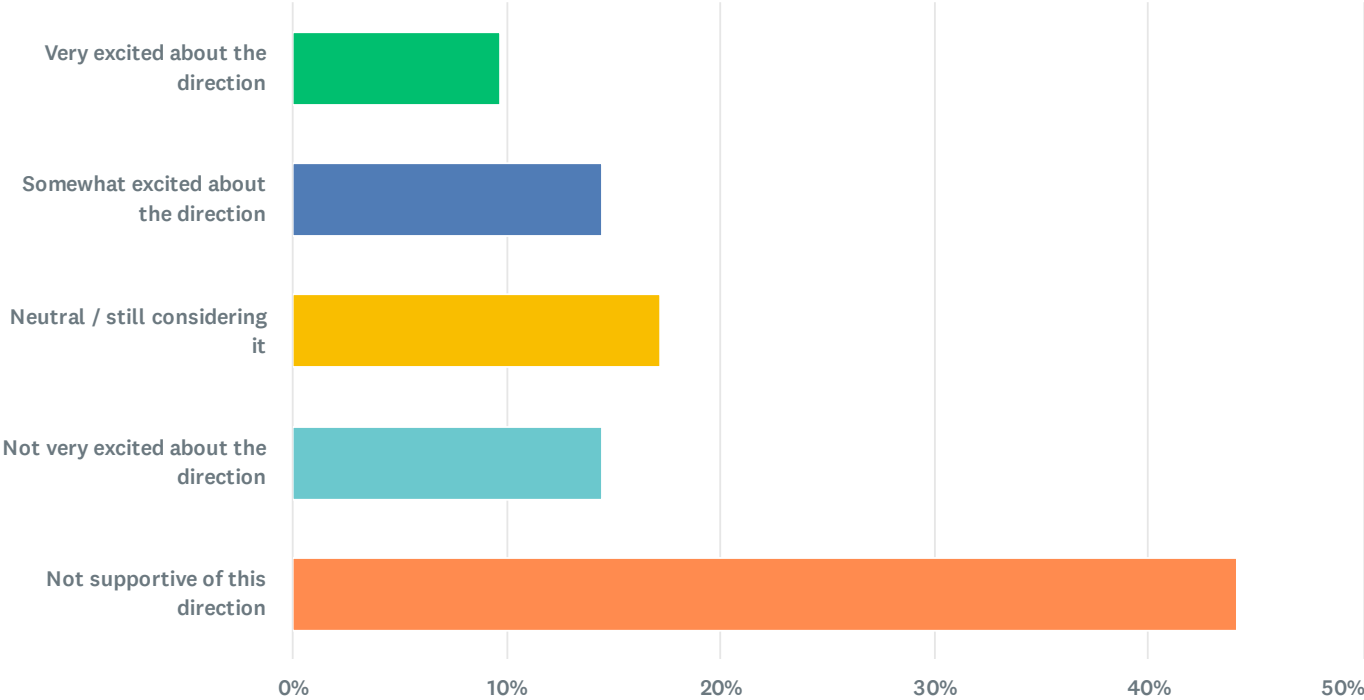

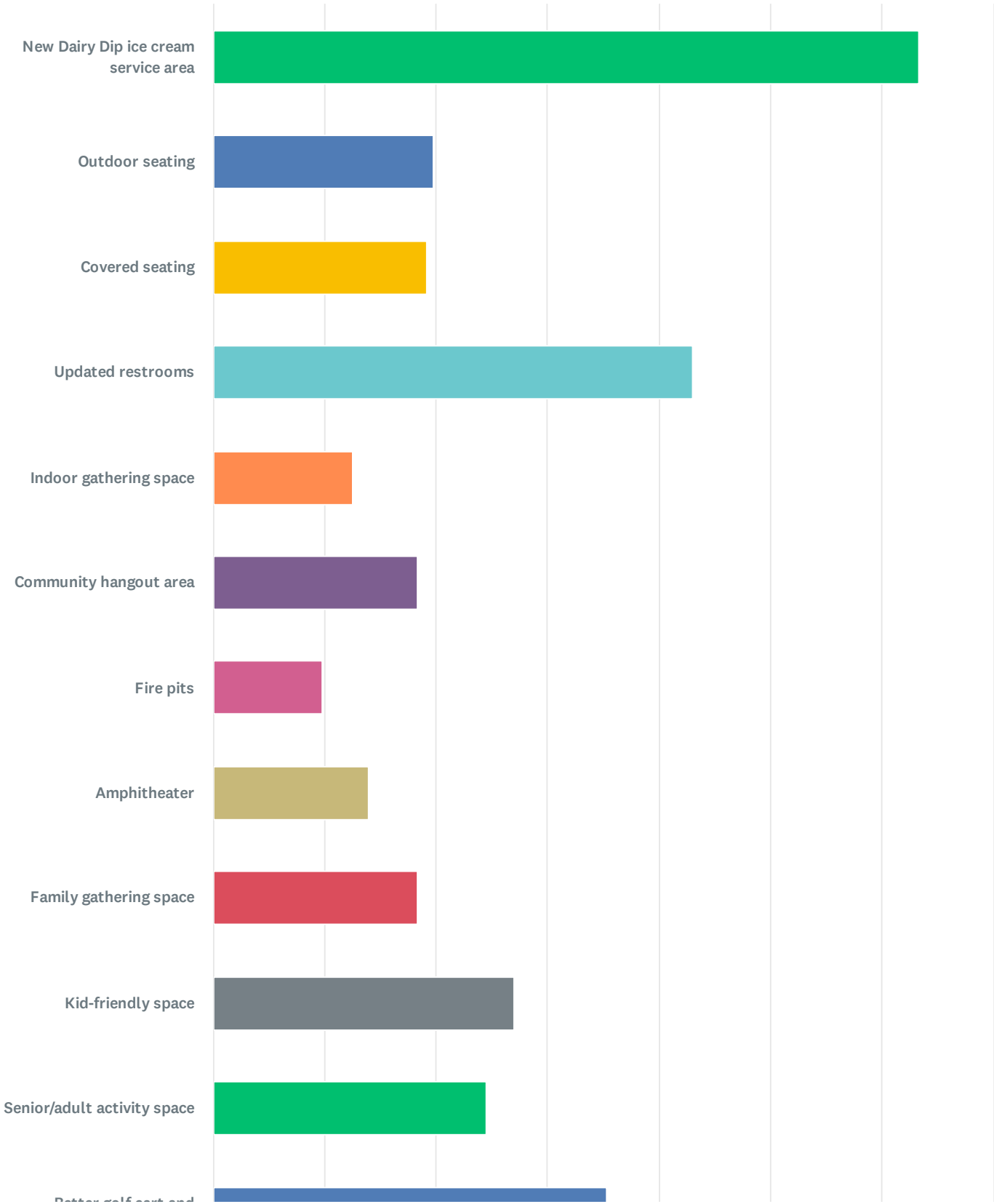

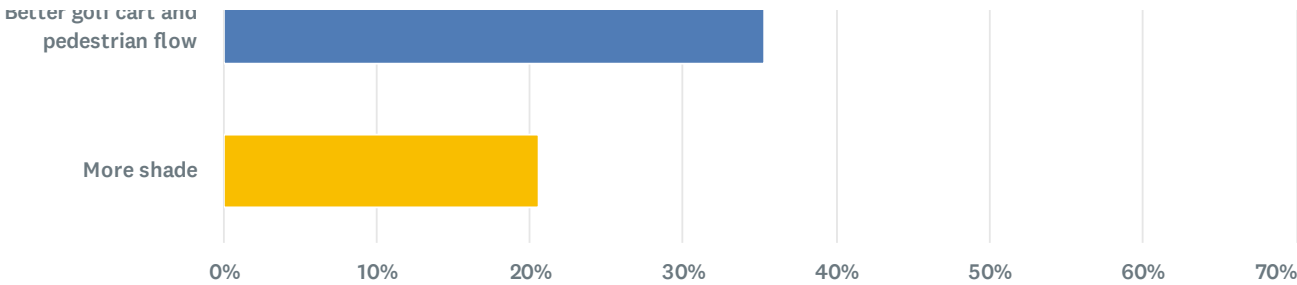

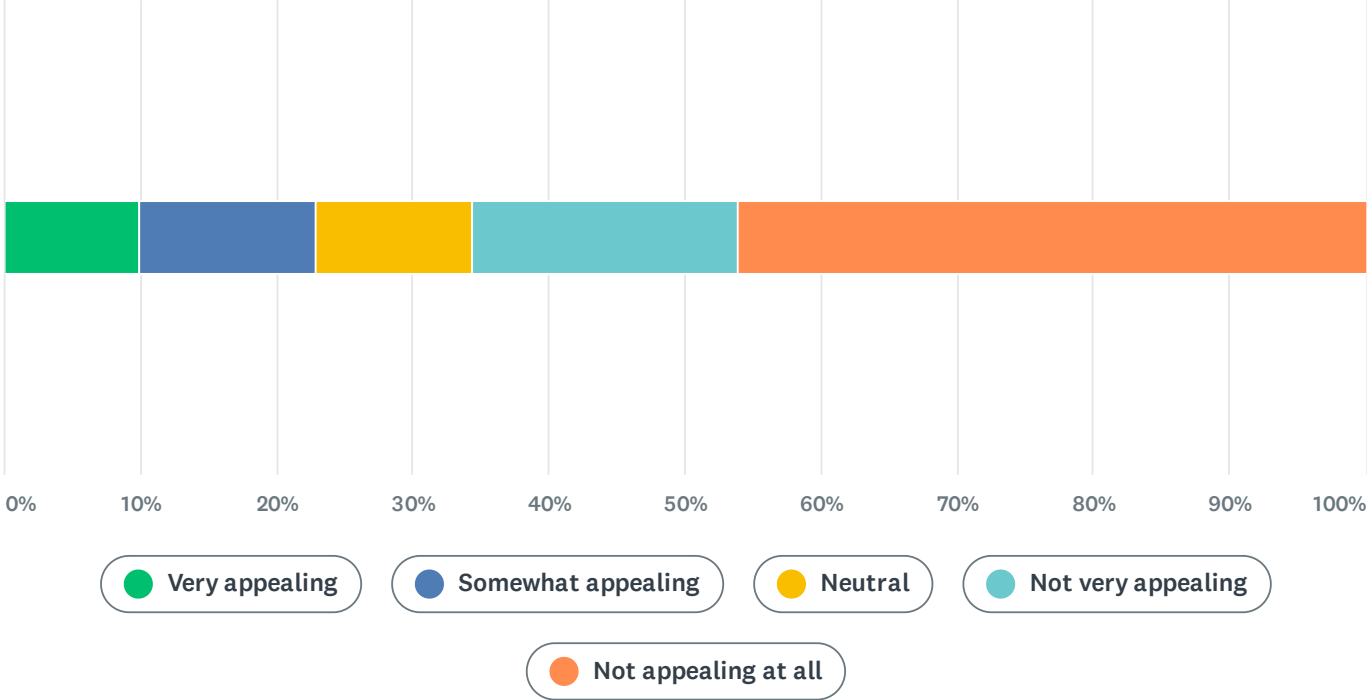

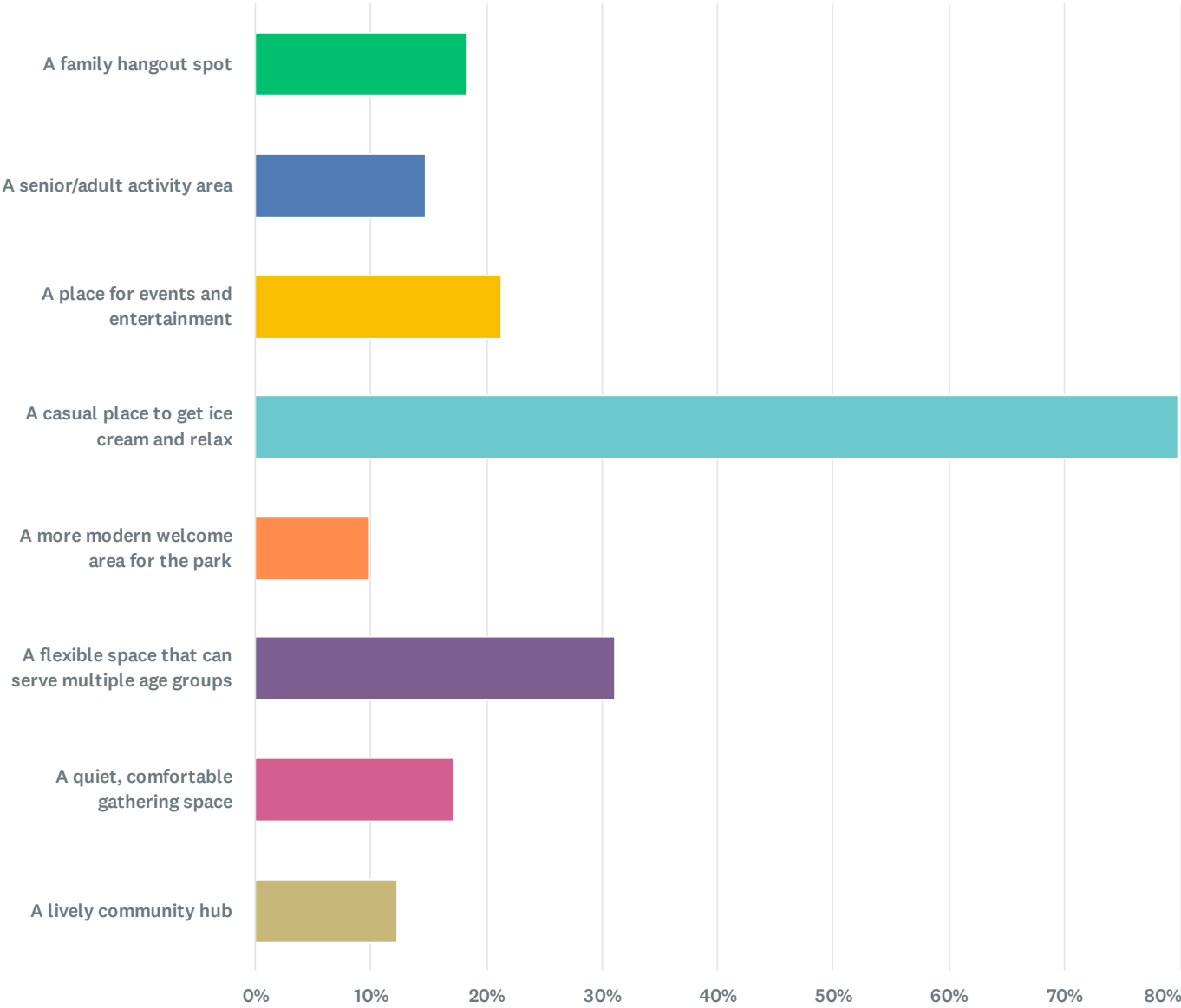

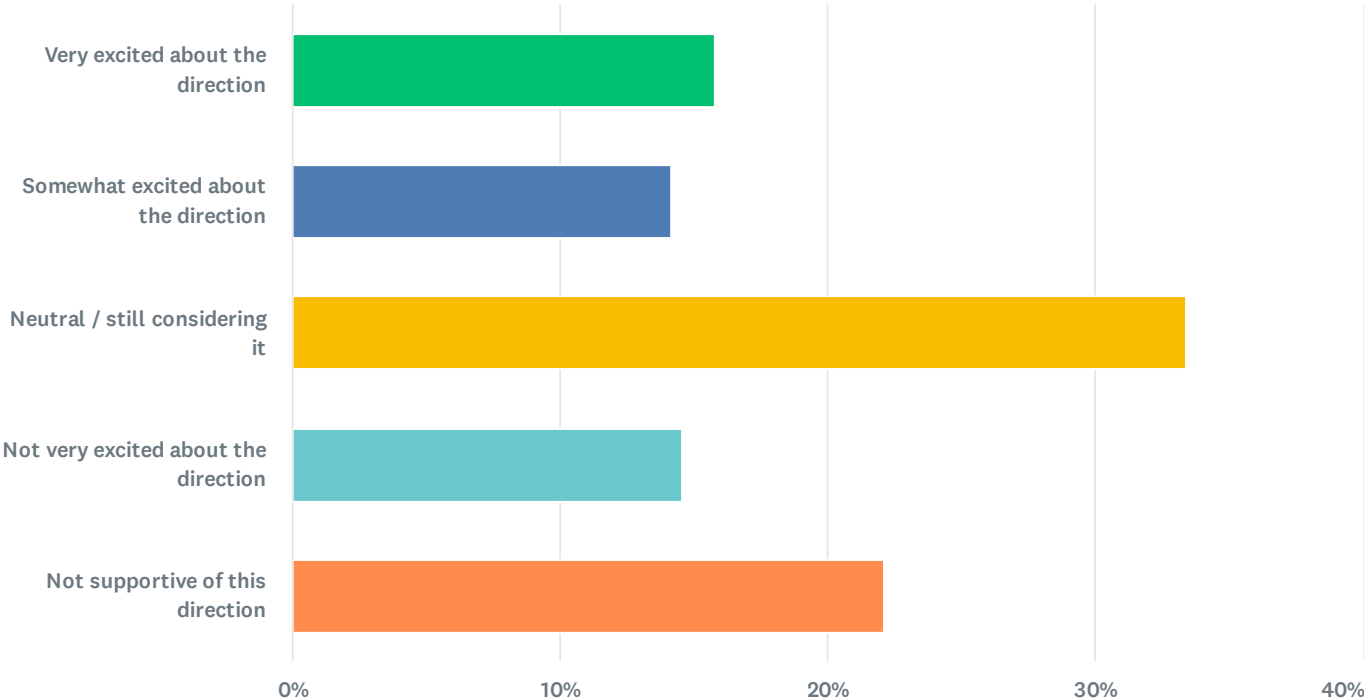

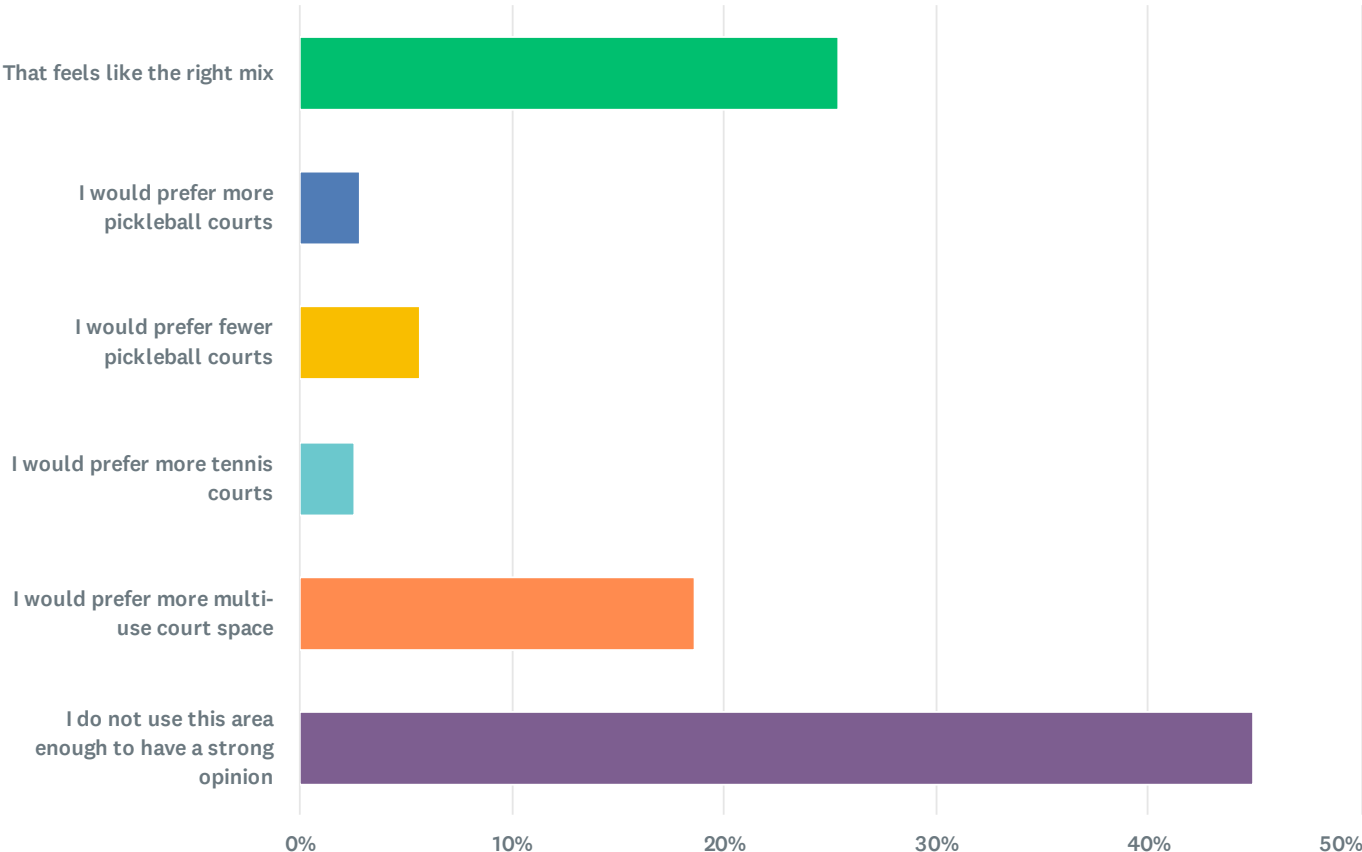

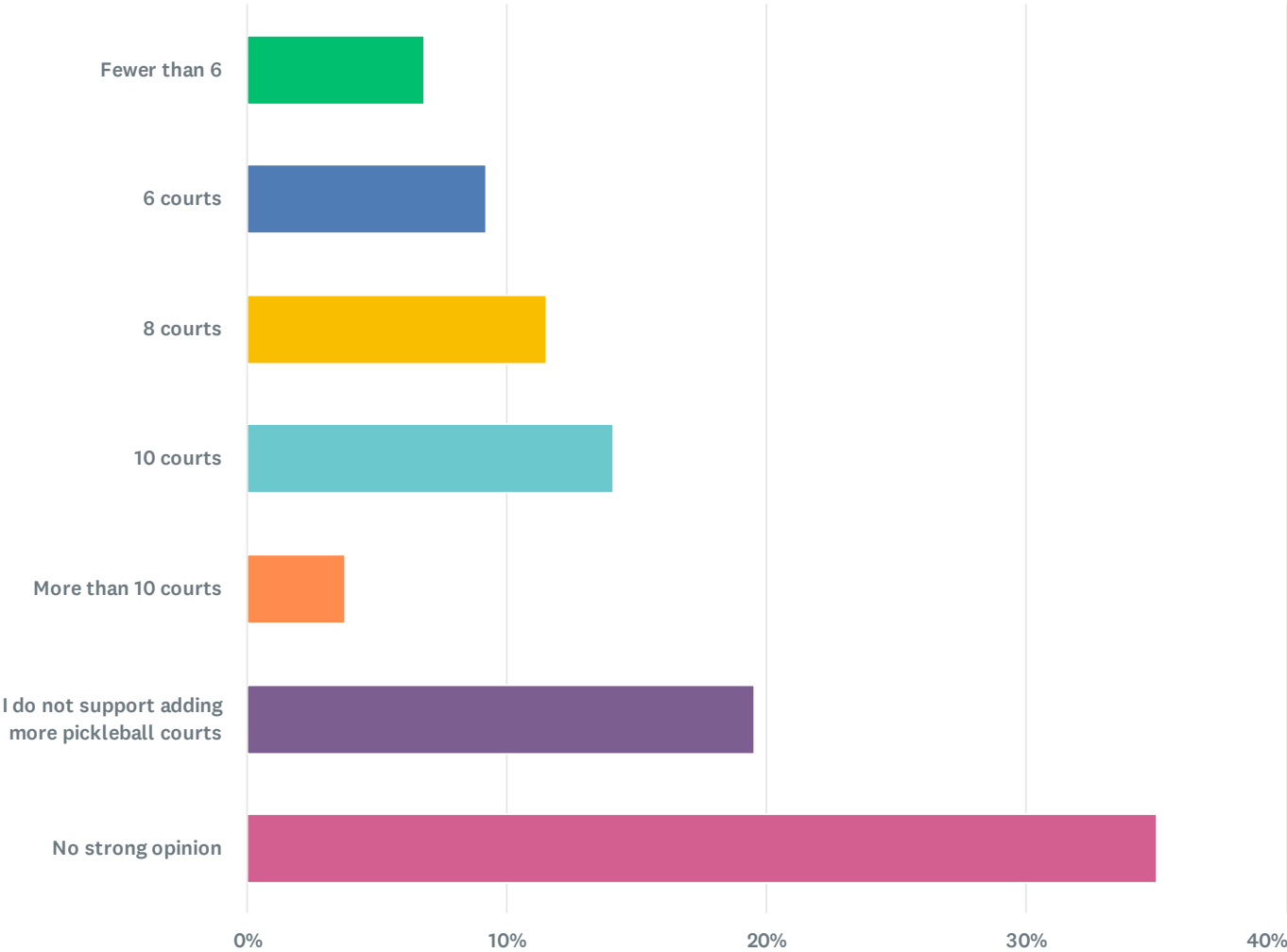

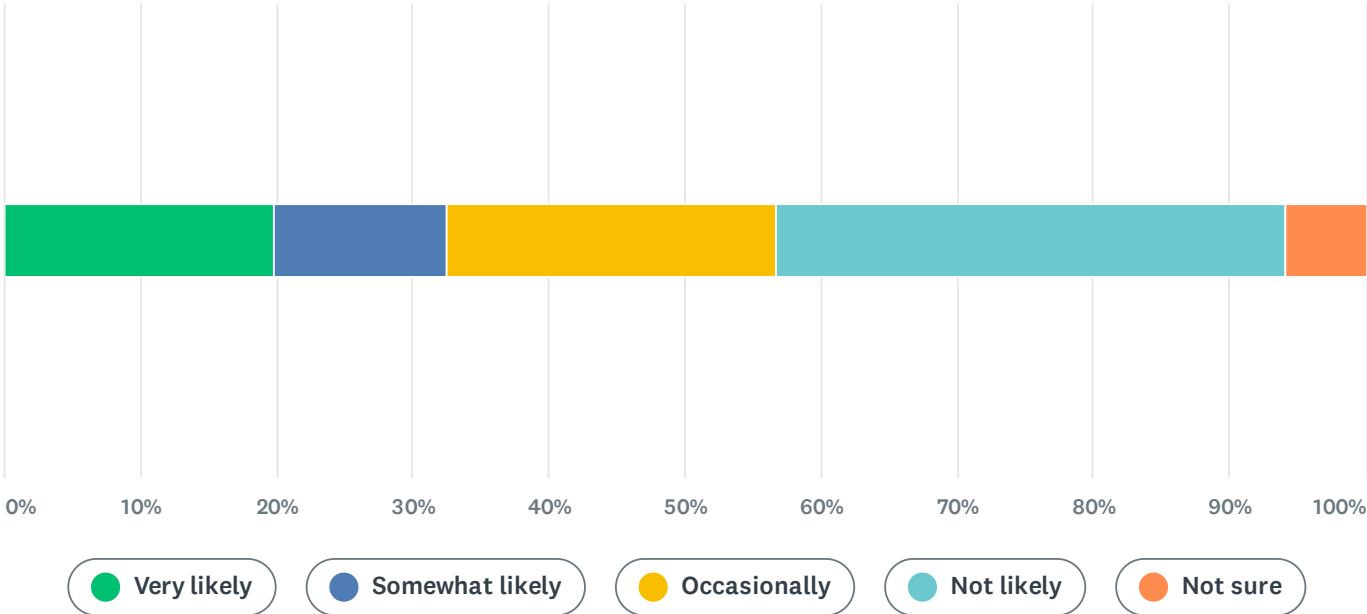

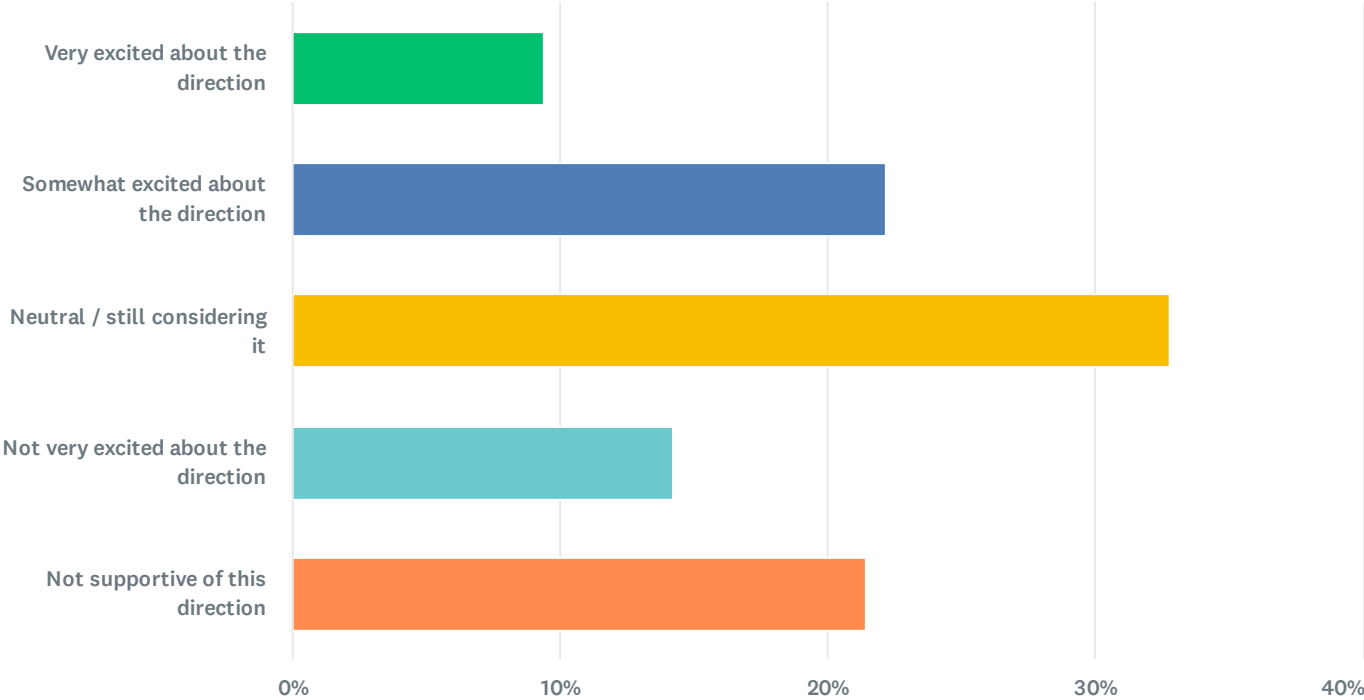

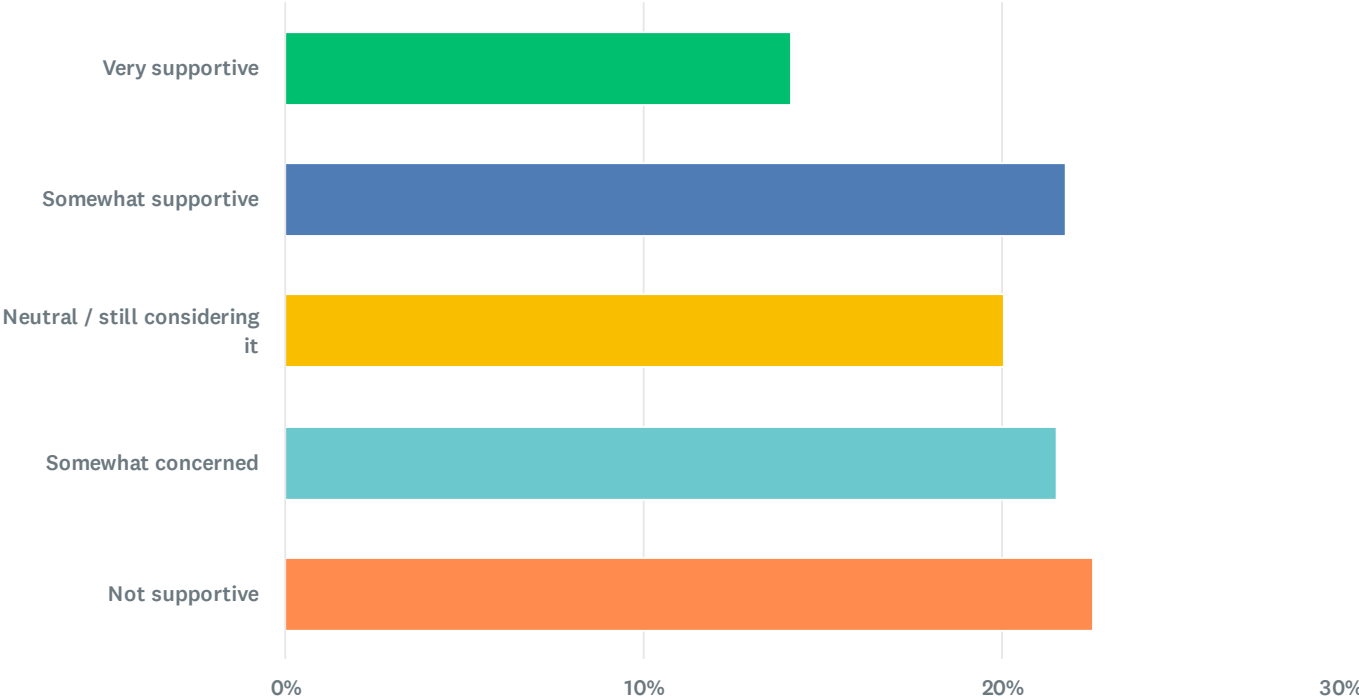

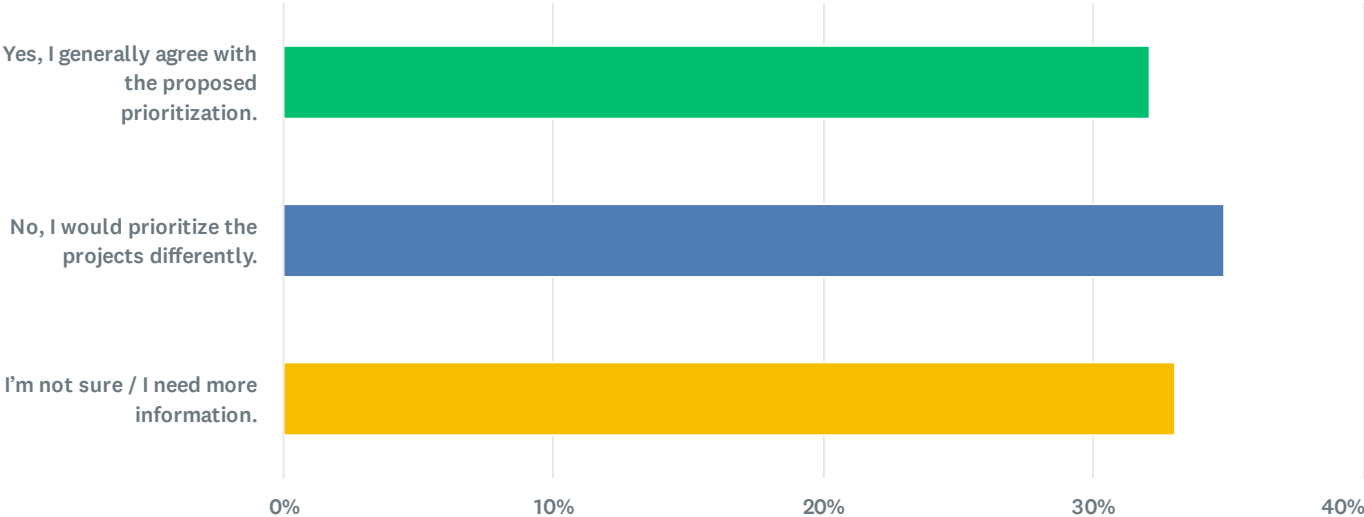

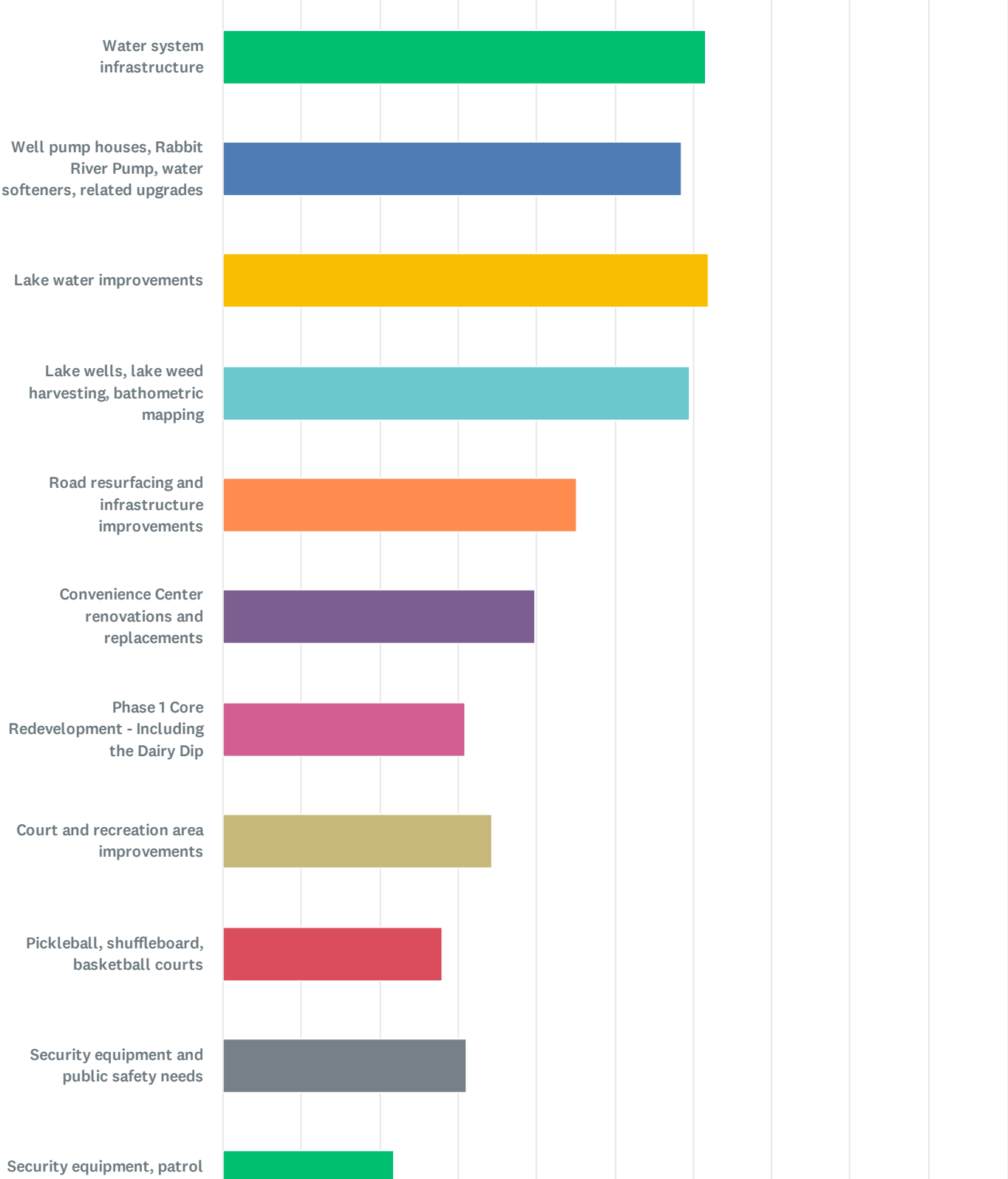

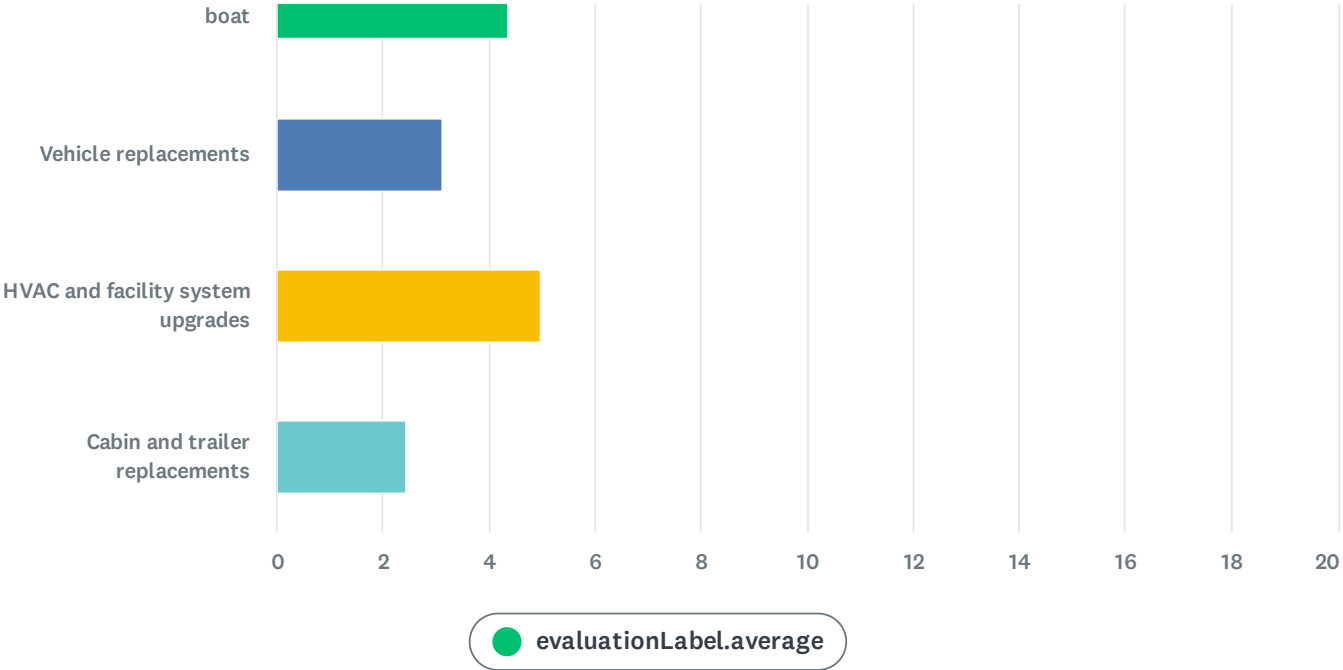

How would you prioritize the proposed project areas in the First Five-Year Plan? Please drag and drop the project areas into the order you believe they should be prioritized, with the most important at the top.

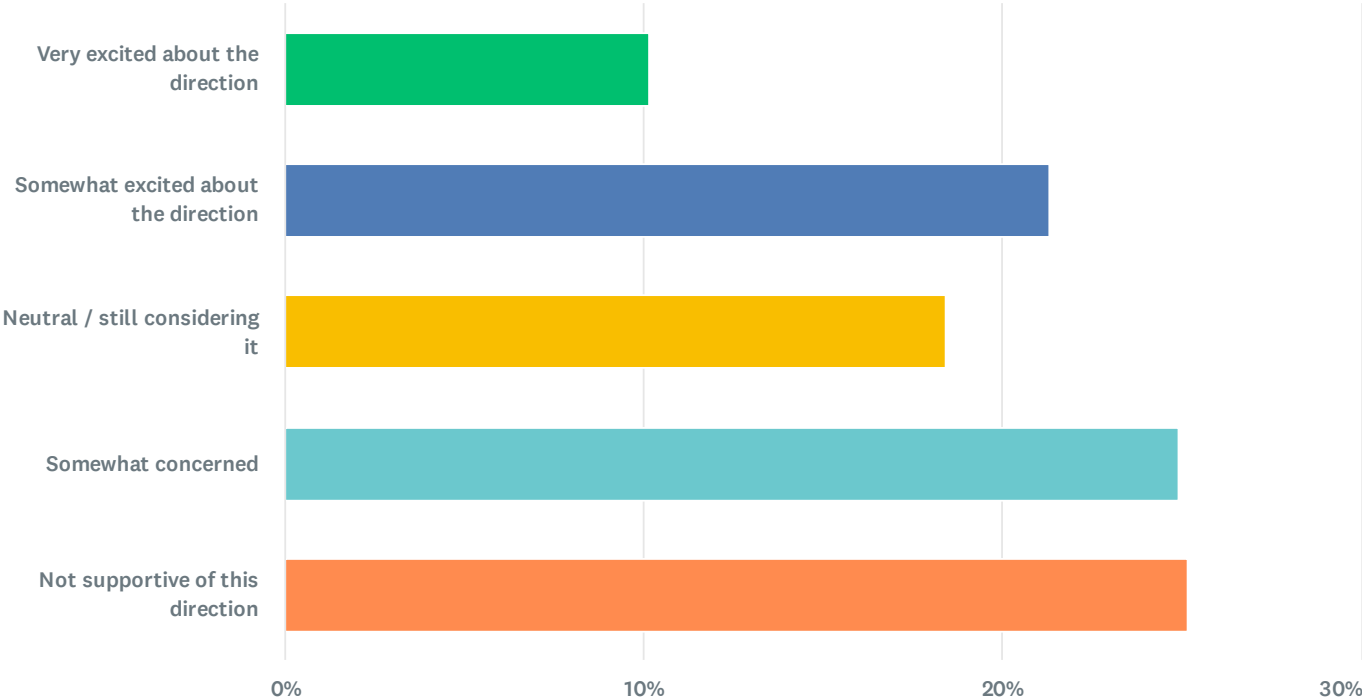

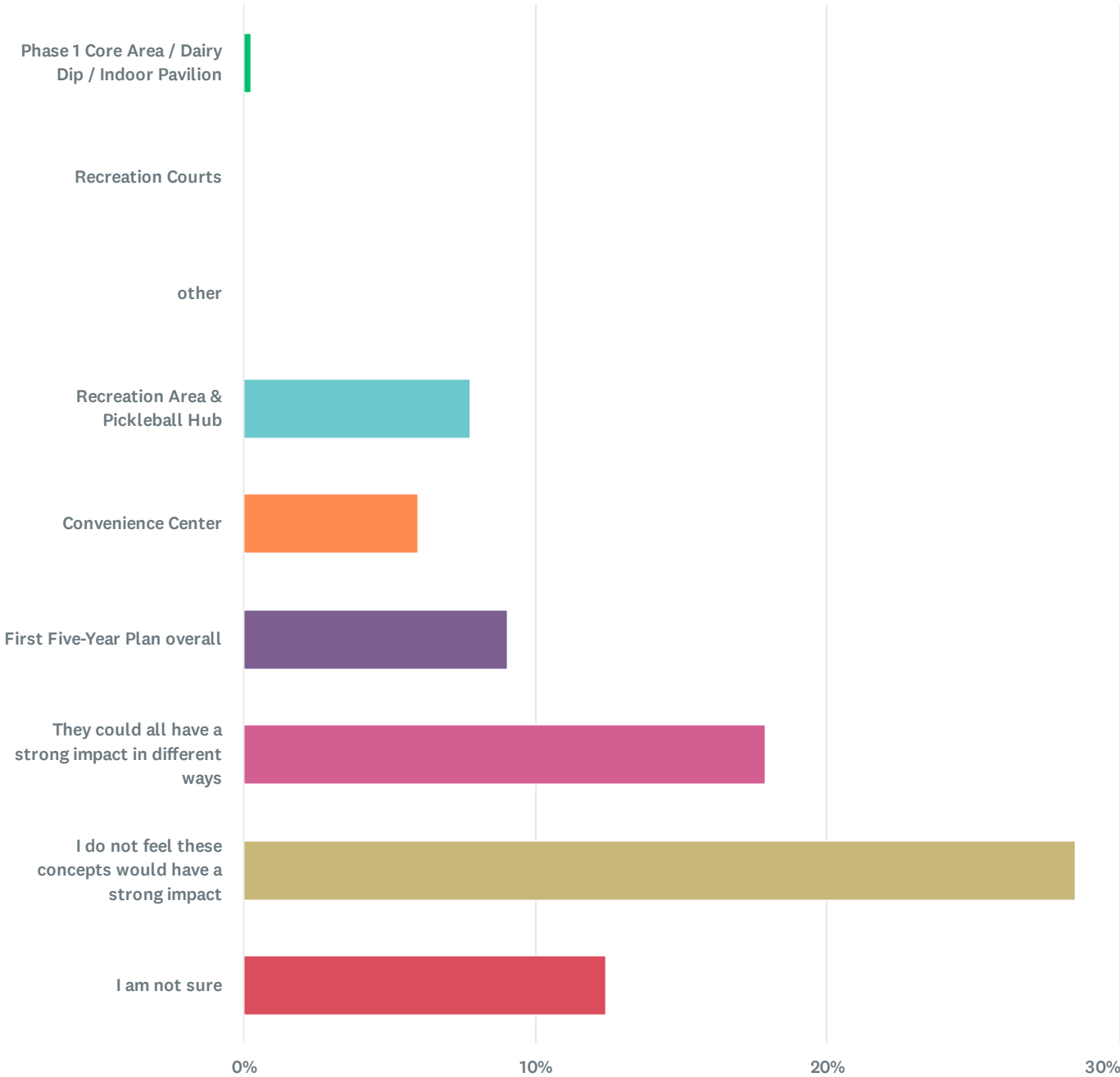

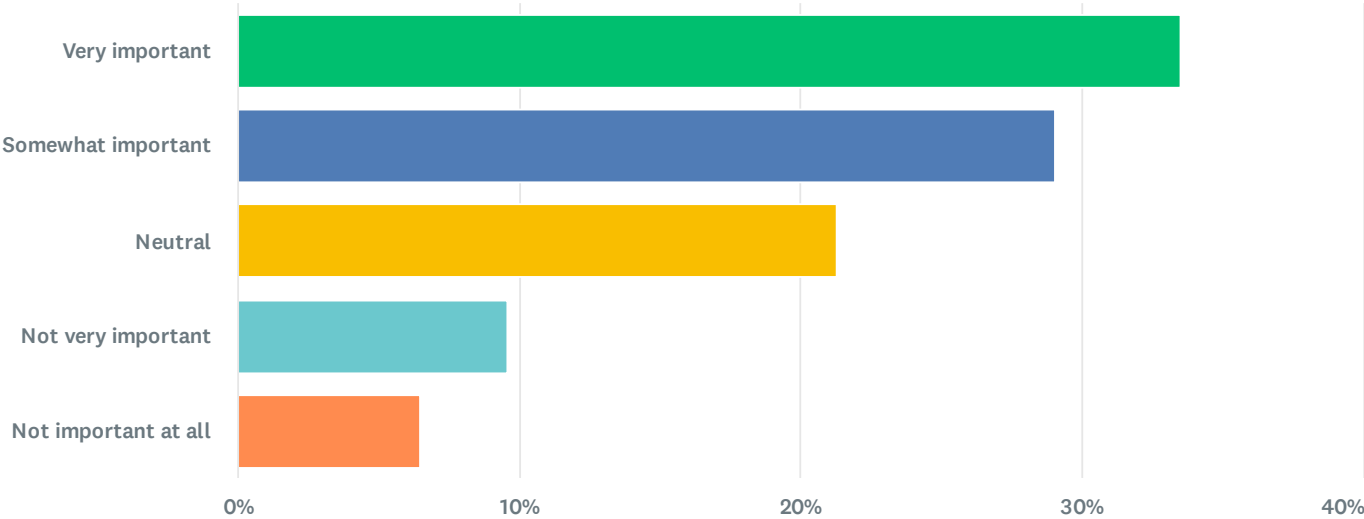

Which concept or plan element do you feel could have the biggest positive impact on the Sandy Pines member experience?



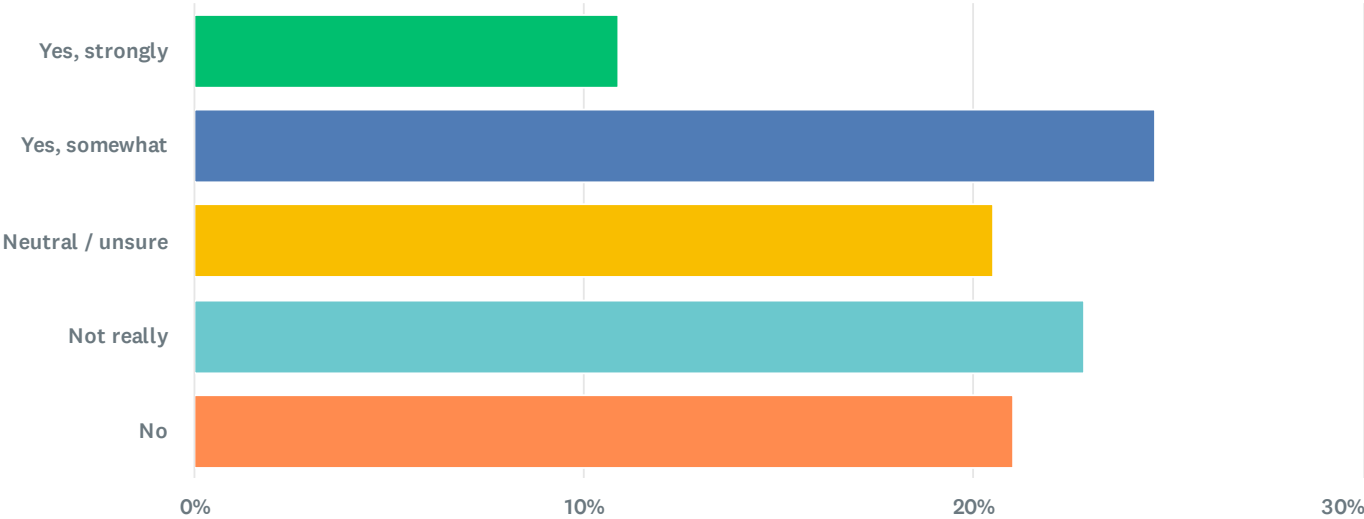
