2023 RENEWALS

We are in the heart of 2023 Renewals. We have an excellent team continuing to serve our members through the renewal process. If you happen to call our Member Service Team for support and are unable to get through, please know they are helping other members. Calls are taking longer than usual as this time of year there is a focus on dusting off how to access the member portal, renewal questions and account details. Know that your call will be returned as soon as possible. A recommended suggestion is to review the FAQ's (Frequently Asked Questions) located on the website <https://sandypines.com/annual-renewals/> to answer login and other process questions you may have to save yourself a phone call. We are receiving positive feedback on our communication and reminders to members to complete 2023 Renewals before they expire. SPECTRUM CHARTER

At the end of January, construction crews started the process of boring outside the park to start installing new cable to run inside Sandy Pines. Again this is a reminder that during the upcoming months, we will have a Spectrum Charter contractor working throughout the park in the green space as well as potentially crossing into member sites. Our regular project reviews with Spectrum Charter continue to show an April completion date. Also launched in January were our FAQ's (Frequently Asked Questions) on our Sandy Pines website. 2023 WATER SOFTENERS

Renewal Period

We are in full customer service mode for renewals. We appreciate your patience as we are spending extended time on the phones to help members with questions which are mainly, “how do we login to our portal” as some may have lost or forgot their login information. We are here to help, but due to the extra time it takes to walk members through the steps, we may not be able to answer other calls immediately. How can members help? We encourage all members to refer to the FAQ’s (Frequently Asked Questions) section on our Sandy Pines website <https://sandypines.com/annual-renewals/>. Members have until February 28, 2023 to complete their renewals. After February 28, 2023, if members have not completed their renewals, their items from 2022 will be carried over and billed accordingly. All fees will be calculated the last two weeks of March 2023 and will appear on your April 2023 statement along with quarterly unit tax and quarterly electric.

Once your renewal has been submitted and approved, you will receive a confirmation letter. If you need help, please reach out to Member Service.

Payment Options

We would also like to remind you of the various payment options available to you:

- In-office – Cash, Check, or Credit Card payment (please note the Public Safety office is available to take payments 24/7 as well, in person only)
- Mail – Check payment
- Online Billing – Make a payment on your account using your MasterCard/Visa/Discover. Convenience fees for MasterCard/Visa/Discover Cards will be 3% of the total payment made. The new payment system will allow your payment to be reflected on your account immediately.
- Recurring ACH Authorization through your bank – Set a designated amount to pay every month through your personal bank that in time will create a credit balance close enough to cover your dues and assessments prior to the new season. If you have any questions or concerns at any time regarding your member statement, we are happy to assist and may be reached by contacting Member Service at 616-896- 8315 ext 100 or 101.

Mail Service Reminders

For those with Sandy Pines mailboxes, we recommend you complete your mail forward requests one month in advance of your transition to or from the park, as it can take two to three weeks for the change of address to take effect. Campers cannot have mail or packages delivered to Sandy Pines.

2023 Seasonal Renewal Portal

As of Tuesday, January 17, 2023, all members should have received an invite to the Member Renewal Portal. Once you receive your email notification from Sandy Pines, you will need to review all renewal items assigned to your account and approve to lock in for the new year. Renewal approvals are due by February 28, 2023. All renewal billings will show up on your April 2023 statements. Renewal stickers will be available in the Administration office after April 10th, 2023.

Annual Dues Payment Schedule

For your reference and information, below is the payment plan schedule if you have elected to make monthly installments to pay for your Annual Dues and Assessments. Your monthly payment this year is \$406.91, and is payable on the 25th of each month, from Oct 2022 thru March 2023. This payment plan is allowed for dues and assessments only. Cost Savings at Sandy Pines

Watching your household expenses is especially difficult in our inflationary times. Everywhere you turn, it's another spike, right? One possible antidote to help curb runaway expenses is an annual self-audit on your insurance premiums. There could be opportunities for savings.

Recent social media activity would suggest that the amounts members are paying for their insurance needs in the park varies more than just a little. While some variance is to be expected, those forking out close to four figures annually may want to take another look-see. These threads also include excellent options for quotations from agents well-versed in SP uniqueness.

Among requirements in the park (up and above the basics for your unit and any outbuilding), you'll need a \$300K policy on your golf carts, \$100K liability coverage on your moped/scooter, plus appropriate coverage on your watercraft per state regulations. Your personal needs should be properly

shielded from loss as the Park's liability protection only goes so far. Again, a local representative with park knowledge is vital to a competitive bid with adequate protection. For instance, understanding that your three-season is a porch and not sleeping quarters can make a difference, as well as the obligatory explanation of appropriate replacement value.

As an aside, another potential opening for cost savings exists in your choice of propane providers. It's much easier to compare pricing amongst them as opposed to insurance carriers as there are fewer to choose from and the variables are virtually nil. You may discover a few extra nickels with a phone call or two, or at least confirm you've got the best deal around. So this winter, let your fingers do the walking and perhaps find a more economical version of these necessities. Oh, and some good news? We're more than halfway through the off-season! VEHICLE STICKERS

Future Potential Projects

Presently two separate FEMA hazard mitigation grants are being written in a joint partnered effort with Salem Township and Sandy Pines to replace CC#1 and CC#2 as a dual-purpose facility as a bathroom and storm shelter. The proposed facilities will be designed in comparison to CC#5 in Phase 3. The size will be approximately 63' x 50'. The proposal also includes a backup generator to be used to power the facilities and water wells to provide water to sites during power outages. The shelter capacity will be 258 people based on five square feet per person. FEMA hazard mitigation grants provide 75% of hardening costs. The architect has designed the buildings to have a life expectancy of over 50 yrs. Both present stick-built buildings have been present for over 50 years. Maintenance does a great job of keeping these facilities operational and looking good. But with all infrastructure, we need to realize that some of our facilities are getting old. With age commonly comes with high maintenance costs. Opportunities to partner with the township and utilize grants to reduce costs is an opportunity to protect people within Sandy Pines and use our money wisely. As indicated, this is an application for a FEMA Hazard Mitigation grant. Applying for a grant does not ensure a successful outcome. In the long term eventually, the convenience centers will have to be replaced.

Membership Cards

Sandy Pines has transitioned to proximity cards. If you or your family members have not transitioned to a proximity card, please take the time to transition before next spring. The cards with the magnetic black stripe on the back of the cards will no longer work to provide park access. To transition to the proximity card please bring your old magnetic stripe card to the Public Safety Office. A replacement or transition to a proximity card is \$10. If you do not have or have lost your magnetic stripe card the cost is \$20 for a new card.

Who May Have A Membership Card?

Persons who are listed on the membership as owning the membership may have a Membership card – a member's card.

- The children or stepchildren of the member-owner may have a membership card – an associate member card.
- The spouse of a member owners' child – an associate card
- The parents of the member may have a membership card – an associate card.
- A membership that has no other associate member may designate one associate member - a designated associate card
- The grandchildren of the member-owner may have a membership card – a grandchild card

In addition, all members, associates, and grandchildren must meet the membership criteria as applicable in the Sandy Pines handbook.

If you knowingly request membership cards for persons other than indicated as legitimate in the Sandy Pines Handbook you may be responsible for park use and entry fees.



Smoke Detectors Save Lives

Please replace the batteries or the smoke detector if you plan to use your camping unit this winter or upon your return to Sandy Pines this spring/summer. Smoke Detectors are very inexpensive, and you should have one in your bedroom, your loft, your porch, and your living quarters. A smoke detector with a 10-year battery can be purchased for as little as \$13 and up online. In addition, consider placing a carbon monoxide detector in your camping unit. The cost of Carbon Monoxide detectors has decreased over the years and can be purchased for as little as \$14 and up. Having smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors in your camping unit protects you and your family.

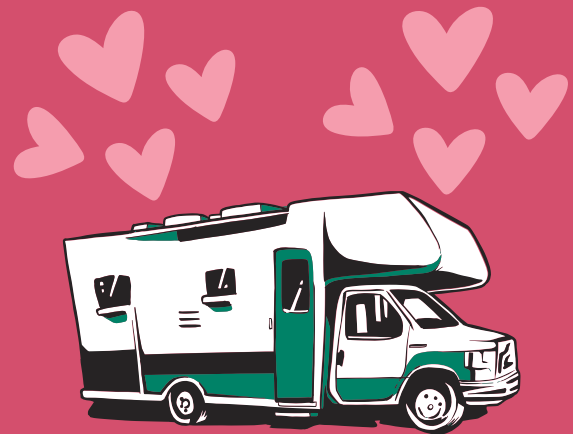

Golf Course Rules

Please be mindful of the following rules of the golf course:

- Absolutely no personal coolers or bringing alcohol or beer to the course.
- Always bring your Sandy Pines member or associate card to be scanned. Cards must be scanned once for each nine you are playing.
- Knobby tires and six-seater golf carts are not permissible on the golf course.
- Proper golf attire is required. No tank tops allowed. Men's shirts must have sleeves. Women's tops must be golf attire.
- Groups of 5 players or more are not allowed without prior permission.
