### Job Summary

The Golf Course Ranger is responsible for enforcing and informing players of Lake Monterey course rules and overseeing the pace of play. They play a key role in ensuring smooth play on the course.

### Duties and Responsibilities

- Greet players with a friendly, approachable, and helpful demeanor.
- Inform players of course rules and regulations; enforce when needed.
- Monitor pace of play on course and communicate needed pace adjustments to players.
- Monitor for and report course condition concerns.
- Monitor for and address player etiquette concerns.
- Provide additional oversight to group outings for a successful event.
- Dump and dispose of trash from course garbage cans.
- Remove and sort returnable cans for deposit from the course.
- Assist with the control of moles on the course.
- Assist with outings and special events by grilling and helping with needed tasks.
- All other duties as assigned.

### Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Ability to work majority of season (April 16<sup>th</sup>-October 13<sup>th</sup>).
- Ability to work some weekends and holidays.
- Must have great customer service skills.
- Must be a team player.
- Strong organizational and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to think on your feet and shift duties based on priorities.

### **Working conditions**

Fun team atmosphere with collaboration spanning many teams and groups within the Park. Fast paced environment in season (April-October). This position involves working in both indoor and outdoor environments. It requires the employee to walk on uneven and various surface types throughout the day including, but not limited to, grass, dirt, pavement, cement, carpet, and tile.

### **Physical requirements**

Must be able to frequently walk, stand, and sit for long periods of time.

Must be able to frequently lift, push, pull, and move 25 lbs.

Must be able to occasionally lift, push, pull, and move 40 lbs.

Must be able to frequently bend, squat, reach, and twist.
