Resolution to Amend Rulebook/Handbook

WHEREAS, the By Laws of Sandy Pines Wilderness Trails, Inc. Article VIII, Section 6(e) gives the Board of Directors the power to “adopt, amend, rescind, and repeal rules and regulations relating to the use of Sandy Pines property and the conduct of its members and their guests.”

WHEREAS, Rules Section III. Items Requiring Permits, Sub Section C. Seepage Pits, Item 3.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors, for the health, safety and welfare of Sandy Pines, believes it is in the best interests of Sandy Pines to amend and clarify the Rules and Regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Sandy Pines Wilderness Trails, Inc. does hereby approve the following amendments and/or additions to the Rules and Regulations relating to Section III. Items Requiring Permits, Sub Section C. Seepage Pits, Item 3 on Sandy Pines Rules, Regulations and Bylaws Handbook (page 39):

Item 3. Existing Language:

The hole must be dug so it will accommodate the drum with 6” of 1 inch stone all around and 12” of stone at the bottom.

Item 3. Amended Language:

The hole must be dug so it will accommodate the drum with a minimum of twelve (12) to eighteen (18) inches of approved seepage stone surrounding the drum, a minimum of eighteen (18) inches of seepage stone below the drum, and a minimum total of two and one-half (2 ½) cubic yards of seepage stone.

Be It Resolved, that the Board of Directors of Sandy Pines Wilderness Trails, Inc. does hereby approve the above Resolution.
