





Letter from the President by Tom Aldrich

We have all been battered by the news media relative to the ‘fiscal cliff’ debacle in Washington. I am happy to report that your Sandy Pines fiscal health continues in excellent condition. The auditors are busy with Dawn Arndt, reviewing the year end financials. However, our preliminary numbers indicate another strong year, both in revenues and cash flow. The golf course has also exceeded our budgeted revenues. The final reviewed financials will be available to the members in the spring.

I have been encouraged by the rapid transition with Gene Van Koevering taking the reins of leadership. He is developing a good relationship with the staff, and they are off and running preparing for another strong year at Sandy Pines.

During this transition I feel it’s imperative to reiterate the responsibilities of the board/staff relationship. The Sandy Pines Bylaws clearly define these respective responsibilities. Essentially, your board sets policy and the staff, under the leadership of the Park Director, administers the policies. Your nine members of the board are all member volunteers, who are elected for a three year term. The bylaws set a two successive term limit. This insures a continuing infusion of new and fresh ideas. Your board collectively is the chief executive authority. The board elects its officers annually at the September board meeting beginning the new fiscal year. The “President” of the board is the spokesman for the board and presides over all board meetings. Each board member has one vote. The “President” title traditionally implies chief operating authority. This is the responsibility of the “Park Director “. I will ask the board to consider changing the “Board President” title to “Chairman of the Board”. I will recommend that the “Park Director” title be changed to “Park President and Chief Operating Officer”. The title changes will better clarify these respective position responsibilities. Any changes in the officer titles must be approved by the BOD and ratified by a majority vote of the membership. We are also making a “clarion” call for members to run for the board. Sandy Pines’ continuing success depends upon participation by its members, not only on the board, but our various active committees.

Enjoy the rest of the winter and “*think spring*”. Before you know it, we will all be together enjoying another great summer at the Pines.

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
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

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PARK RANGER NEWS by Steve Deyarmond

Membership cards:

Membership cards are automatically renewed each spring. The administration office sends each membership a list of member, associate and grandchild cards that have been issued to your membership. Please return the form with any changes. If you do not have any changes you do not have to return the form.

The Membership cards for memberships that have had a past due balance for over of 60 days are deactivated. These cards are not automatically renewed. The memberships balance must be brought current and once the balance is current the rangers can reactivate the cards on your membership.

The cost to reactivate a card(s) that has been turned off due to a 60 day past due balance is \$20 for one card , \$40 for two cards, \$55 for three to four cards and \$80 for five cards or more cards.

Types of membership cards that are issued:

Member cards – these are issued for the person(s) owning a membership

Associate cards - These are issued for the Member/owners parents, children and children's spouses

Grandchildren cards – These are issued for the members/owners grandchildren

Designated associate – these are issued to one person memberships that have no associates or Grandchildren. A membership may have one designated associate.

Water park and Adult Lounge cards - These permit access into the Water Park, Adult Lounge and leaf dump. This type of card will not permit access at the entrance gates. The cost for this card is \$6.

Membership cards for associate and grandchildren under 16 who were issued to utilize the golf course membership, are reactivated at a charge of \$4 – These cards will appear on your renewal as recreation cards.

Brothers, sisters, uncles, aunts and friends are not permitted to be issued membership cards.

If you need a Member card for your spouse, parent, child, child's spouse, or grandchild, or would like a designated associate card, you may return the form with your request, call the Ranger Station at 616-896-9006, or stop at the Ranger Station. The cost for a new card is \$10.

Ranger Positions:

The Ranger Department will have several part time positions open this summer. We will be staffing persons in the Ranger Station, patrol positions and boat patrol positions. Positions will consist of 8 - 40 hrs/week and will include weekends and holidays. If interested, please submit an application.
