Flea Market:

Upcoming dates are June 11 and July 2. Flea Markets run from 9 am to 2 pm. Spaces are 10x20, and are available for \$25. Dogs are not allowed at the Flea Markets, whether they are carried, on a leash or in a golf cart.

Flea Market Vendors:

You must park your vehicle on your Flea Market space or at the Maintenance parking lot. You are not allowed to park in the office parking lot, due to limited space.

Pumpouts:

Can be ordered online now, as long as we have an email address in our system for you. Orders can be placed up until 11:45 pm for next day service. No online orders for same day or Sunday pumpouts. Kiosks with computers are available at the Ranger's Station (Main gate and Phase 3), Member Service and the Adult Rec. Center. You can still call into the pumpout order line 616-896-8315 ext 111. Leave your name, site number, and the pumpout dates. We will bill your account. You must place your orders by 4 pm the day before your scheduled day. Phase 1 will need to call in by noon on Saturdays.

Outdoor Storage: (By the ball diamond)

We have added more spaces, and all of the spaces have been numbered. We need to know what space you are currently parking in, so it can be assigned to you. We will give you a special sticker that allows you to park in the outdoor area and lets the Rangers know that you have paid for it, and you belong there.

Bullpen Storage: (Behind retail stores)

Bullpen renters must stop at the office to update information on their application and to pick up a special sticker for each item they are storing.

As of May 15, we have traveled 957.7 miles to start off our trip which totals 12,670 miles. This includes a carry-over from last year's trip...mileage walked last year but not picked up until this year, and from the ten members who have turned in their mileage for this season.

I will begin listing a total for each individual as of June 1. Mileage slips are available at Member Service or the Ranger Station.

We have gone past the Cuyahoga Valley National Park in Ohio, the Saratoga National Historical Park in New York, and are 222.3 miles from stop number three, Arcadia National Park, in Maine. We have 11,712.3 miles to complete our trip and return to Sandy Pines.



Golf cart driving permits:

Youth wishing to drive a golf cart that are 12 years of age or older must take the Golf Cart Safety Course before operating a golf cart in the Park. The safety packet information is online at the SandyPines.com website, or you may pick up a hard copy at the Ranger Station. After your child studies the packet he/she may come to the Ranger Station, show proof of age and take the written test. If they pass, they will be issued a permit to drive a golf cart in the Park. If they are 12 years of age, he/she must operate the golf cart with an adult (18+). If the youth is 13, he or she must operate the golf cart with an adult for three weeks. A youth golf cart permit is \$5.

Rental Golf Carts:

To operate a rental cart in the Park, you must be at least 18 years of age. Please remind your family members and guests.

Insurance:

The Park requires that you have \$100,000 liability insurance on your golf cart, moped and watercraft. Spring is a good time to review your insurance coverage on your vehicles. If you have made modifications or additions to your trailer, park model or placed a new shed/garage on your site, you may want to review the coverage you have on these items and the contents.

Weather siren:

The weather siren located in the Park is activated by Allegan County Central Dispatch.

This weather siren is tested the fourth Friday of each month at around 11 am. The weather siren is activated for severe weather threats. When activated, members and their families should seek shelter. Each family should have a family discussion on a pre-planned place to take shelter, and parents should talk to their children about alternatives if they are out on a golf cart or on the lake in a boat. Members should be observant to changing weather conditions and watches

Smoke Detectors and Carbon Monoxide Detector:

Upon your arrival back to your trailer, please replace your smoke detector batteries and check your smoke detector for proper operation. The few moments of replacing your batteries and checking the smoke detector could save you and your family's lives.

Check your fire extinguishers. If they are old or if the pressure is low replace it.

Remember to check the fire extinguisher on your boat.

If you do not have a carbon monoxide detector in your camping unit, please consider installing one to protect your family.

Maintaining your golf cart:

Please take the time to check your golf cart before driving this spring/summer. Check the head and tail lights, braking system, steering system, tire tread and proper inflation. Please do not drive the golf cart or permit the golf cart to be driven by youth until all items are working and can be safely driven. Several businesses within, or close to the Park, work on golf carts.

Golf cart and Moped Site Numbers:

Your golf cart must have site numbers at least three inches in height on the front and rear of the golf cart in a contrasting color to the cart.

Mopeds are required to have site numbers at least two inches in height on the front and rear of the golf cart.
