

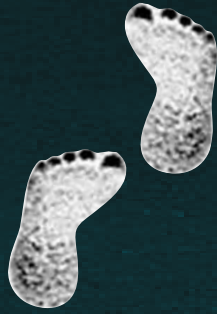

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Membership cards:

Membership cards are automatically renewed each spring. The Administration Office sends each membership a list of member, associate and grandchild cards that have been issued to your membership. Please return the form with any changes. If you do not have any changes, you do not have to return the form.

The Membership cards that have had a past due balance for over of 60 days are deactivated. The membership balance must be brought current, and once that has occurred, the Rangers can reactivate your cards.

The cost to reactivate a card(s) that has been turned off due to a 60 day past due balance is \$20 for one card, \$40 for two cards, \$55 for three-four cards and \$80 for five or more cards, if activated all at once.

Types of membership cards that are issued:

Member cards – are issued for the person(s) owning a membership;

Associate cards - are issued for the Member/Owners parents, children and children's spouses;

Grandchildren cards – are issued for the members/owners grandchildren;

Designated Associate cards – are issued to one-person memberships that have no Associates or grandchildren. A membership may have one designated Associate.

Water Park and Adult Lounge cards - these cards permit access into the Water Park, Adult Lounge and leaf dump. This card does not allow access at the entrance gates. The cost for this card is \$4, annually.

Brothers, sisters, uncles, aunts and friends, are **not** permitted to be issued membership cards.

If you need a Member card for your spouse, parent, child, child's spouse, grandchild or would like a designated Associate card, you may return the form with your request, call the Ranger Station at 616-896-9006, or stop at the Ranger Station. The cost for a new card is \$10.

New for this Year - Guest Registration over the internet:

Remember the days when you had to drive to the Ranger Station, wait in a line to get a guest pass, and then handwrite the pass? We are in a time of transition.

By the beginning of summer we plan to have Guest Registration available over the Internet. Yes, you will be able to sit in your easy chair and register people coming to Sandy Pines. No more rush to beat your guests to the Main gate.

How's this going to work? Each Member/Owner will have a user name and password to access the Guest Registration database. You must have an e-mail address on file at the office to get log-in access. Once signed into the database, the software will lead you through some simple information prompts to provide your guest's name and date of arrival, and then 'presto' your guest is registered.

You will then have the opportunity to print a Guest Pass, or email the Guest Pass for the guest to print. On this Pass will be a PIN number. The PIN number is important for your guest's entry into the Park. The PIN number will be needed to gain access into the Park. We have installed PIN number pads at the Main Gate Ranger Station and the Phase Three Ranger Station. Your guest will pull up to the gate, enter his/her PIN number, the gate will open and your guest will be on their way to your site. The PIN number will only work once, and the Guest Pass must be displayed in the lower left corner of the dash. If your guest leaves the Park, he/she will have to show the pass to a Ranger for access back into the Park.

If you do not have an Internet connection or computer at Sandy Pines, we will be providing remote terminals for you to register your guests. These terminals will be at The Adult Recreation Center in Phase 4, The Administration Library (open 8:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday-Friday and 8:30 am to Noon on Saturdays), the Phase Three Gate Ranger Station, and the Main Gate Ranger Station.

First off, if you are a registered contractor with the Park, please make sure to renew your contractor status before April 1st, to avoid having your cards shut off. If you have paid your fee with the office, make sure to also complete a new contractor application form and send me a copy of your insurance before April 1st. Having one or more of these items not completed will result in your contractor cards being shut off.
