Flea Market Vendors: Remember to park at your flea market spot or at the Maintenance parking lot. You are not allowed to park in the office lot, due to limited space. Items sold at the flea market cannot use the Sandy Pines logo, and items must comply with our rules. That means, if it cannot be used in the Park, it cannot be sold at the Flea Markets (fireworks, scooters, etc.)

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PARK RANGER NEWS by Steve Deyarmond

Memorial Day Weekend Bass Fishing Contest: The Ranger Department will be hosting the Annual Bass Fishing Contest. Opening day for Bass fishing is May 26th. Stop in or call the Ranger Station at 616-896-9006 to enter. All persons must enter before the start of the contest (May 26th). Contest runs from May 26-28th, and ends at 3 pm. All entries must be weighed in by 3 pm on May 28th. The contest winner will be determined by the weight of a single Bass. Entry fee is \$10 per entrant. First prize is \$100. Contestants must bring the Bass to the Ranger Station to be weighed. We support catch and release. Funds other than prize money will go toward the restocking of fish into the lake.

Michigan's Free Fishing Weekend and Youth Fishing Contest: June 9-10, is Michigan's Free Fishing Weekend. On those dates, a fishing license is not required by the State. This is a great time to spend some time with your children or grandchildren. During this weekend, the Ranger Department will sponsor a Youth Fishing Contest with prizes. Largest fish will be determined by weight. Any species in season may be entered. Plan ahead, to spend some time with your child or grandchildren. We should have a great fishing weekend! No fees or sign up is required.

You must bring the fish to the Ranger Station to be weighed and recorded. Contest begins on June 9th and ends June 10th at 8 pm.

Golf Cart Registration Stickers: When receiving your golf cart registration stickers this spring, please check your golf cart for the required site numbers on the front and rear of the golf cart. Your site numbers must be at least three inches in height, in contrasting color of the golf cart, and highly visible. Golf Cart Registration Stickers were mailed to members in April. Please affix these stickers to your golf cart. If you did not receive a golf cart registration sticker, it can be purchased at the Ranger Station or at the Member Service Office.

Rental Golf Carts: To operate a rental golf cart within the Park, an individual must be at least 18 years of age, with a valid State issued operators permit. In the event that a person is found operating a rental golf cart within the Park that is under the age of 18 years, the Ranger Staff will stop the golf cart, take the rental golf keys, issue a violation, and inform the rental agency. This may result in the loss of the rental cart, and any rental fees.



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Community Service Program

Youth under the age of 18 years of age will have the option of performing community service or paying their violation fines. In the past, community service was issued as a result of arbitration. This change will provide an alternative to youth and the membership. Please contact the Safety Director for information, or to participate.




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Inspector News by Ron Lancaster

One thing that always seems sure in the spring, is that many members are wanting to remove trees from their site. Please bear with me as we review the procedure. First, please remember that all trees in the Park are the property of the Park, and therefore, you will need a permit to cut down any tree larger than 4" in diameter.

The procedure for obtaining a permit is as follows:

1. You must stop in my office between 8:30-9:30 am or 3:30-4:30 pm, and apply for a permit;
3. You will be given a ribbon to tie around the tree or trees you wish removed;
3. I will come to your site as soon as possible, and mark the tree or trees with orange paint;
4. You may, at that point, remove the trees that I have marked.

Please remember that to protect you and your neighbors, you must use a Park approved tree service, because of liability. If the tree service is not approved by the Park, they will not be permitted into the Park. If they are not authorized, you may have them contact me, and I can get them approved under the guidelines of the Handbook.

Also, June 10th, is our clean-up date, so please have your sites cleaned and ready for the new summer season.

Working together, we can help Sandy Pines be the best in the Midwest!

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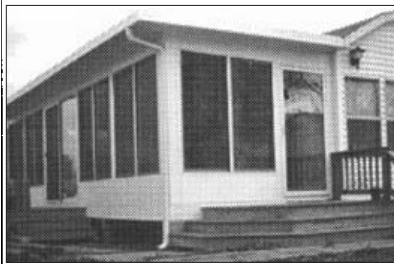

Happenings at Sandy Pines during the winter of 2006-07

Listed below are the changes that were made at Sandy Pines while you were away. Please take a moment to look them over so you are aware of what's new this season.

We replaced the flat roof over the Indoor Pool; re-roofed the Retail Center; cut down dead trees in Phase 4 Green Areas; added new storage bins at Park and Garden which will allow us to sell a variety of different items; installed a new ceramic floor in the Ice Cream Shop.

We installed nine new security lights in Phases 2, 4 and 3; Maintenance added siding to the remaining CC's; and construction of another condo has begun. We resided the Golden Onion; replaced the light fixtures in CC's 11 and 12; cleaned up the fallen trees in the green areas in Phase 2; finished siding the CC's in Phase 2; replaced the equipment at the car wash; and created a link on our website to sell Sandy Pines clothing.

We revised the Golf Cart Instructional Booklet and the test for a golf cart license, and we have made the Booklet available on our website. A new heavy duty electric line has been installed at the entrance to the Park. This should take care of the problems that we had last year with the line coming down many times. This line feeds Phase 2 and sections of Phase 1 and the Condo's well house.

We will be replacing the deck flooring around the Golden Onion this spring; we installed new vinyl siding on CC #9, and then will start on CC #10. Sandy Pines and Lake Monterey Golf Course received a special award from the Allegan County Conservation District this week. We were recognized for our use of organic chemicals at the Golf Course, and for the planting of native Michigan flowers and plants along the creek at the Golf Course. Over 15,000 plants were put in to help stop erosion. They give out one award each year, and

we were selected to receive it this year.

We cleaned up the fallen trees in the green areas in Phase 3; we set up a Cooperative Advertising program with Grand Rapids RV. We will offer one free night of camping if they purchase two or more nights. Grand Rapids RV has put together a flyer that they will give to people who purchase from them.

We will be planting 1,000 perch in the lake this spring. We have been planting fish for the last ten years. This will be our first time planting perch. I had a meeting with a Professional Lake Management representative whose expertise is fish. We have planted walleye, blue gill and cat fish over the last ten years, and he felt that we could introduce perch to the lake.

We are trying an experimental program with new light bulbs in some of the CCs. We're going to use florescent bulbs which use only 15 watts of energy, instead of the 60 watt bulbs we are currently using; and the Maintenance staff sided the Pavilion in Phase 3.

We added a Dog Park for our members to let their dogs run loose. This is located in front of the entrance to the Nature Trails on 26th Street. We have had many dog owners request this over the years, and we finally found a place to locate it.

We are replacing the concrete at the front entrance to the Pavilion to make it easier for wheelchairs and our senior members; installing siding on the well houses around the Park; we added a water softener system

to CC#6 in Phase 3, for the Laundromat.

Senior Adult Activities supplied five new benches that were put in the playground areas and they also provided five new flag poles and flags, that have been installed at the Main Entrance, Core Beach, and Administration Entrance to the Park. Special thanks to the Senior Adult Activities group for their generosity.

We refurbished the front concrete steps to the Golden Onion and Indoor Pool building; updated the Member Handbook/Permit Book, and included it on the member's only section of the Sandy Pines Web site. It will be printed next year after the Rules Committee has a chance to study the content.

We added six new wireless internet locations around the Park. We now have seven areas for computer usage. Ranger Station; CC#3; Flea Market area and Library; Water Works Area; Outdoor Pool; Golden Onion and beach area; and Core area and beach; we will be installing a shade cover area at the Phase 3 Outdoor Pool; and we added five more security cameras around the Park. This will give us added security throughout the year.

So...while you were away, a lot of changes were made in and around Sandy Pines, and we hope that you are able to enjoy them all!

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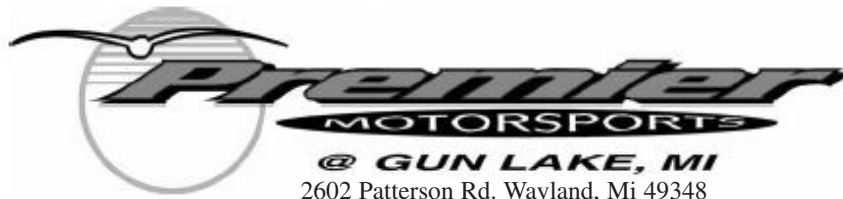

We are excited about the upcoming year at Sandy Pines and we hope you enjoy this year at the Golden Onion.

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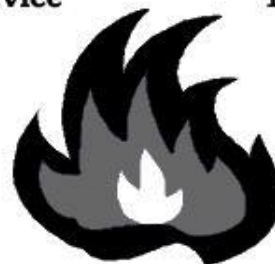
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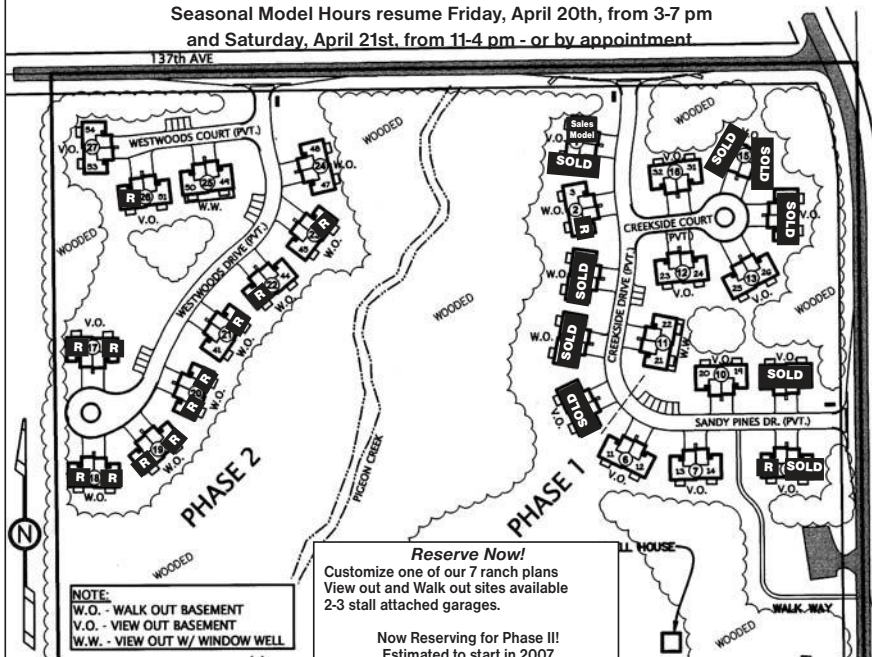
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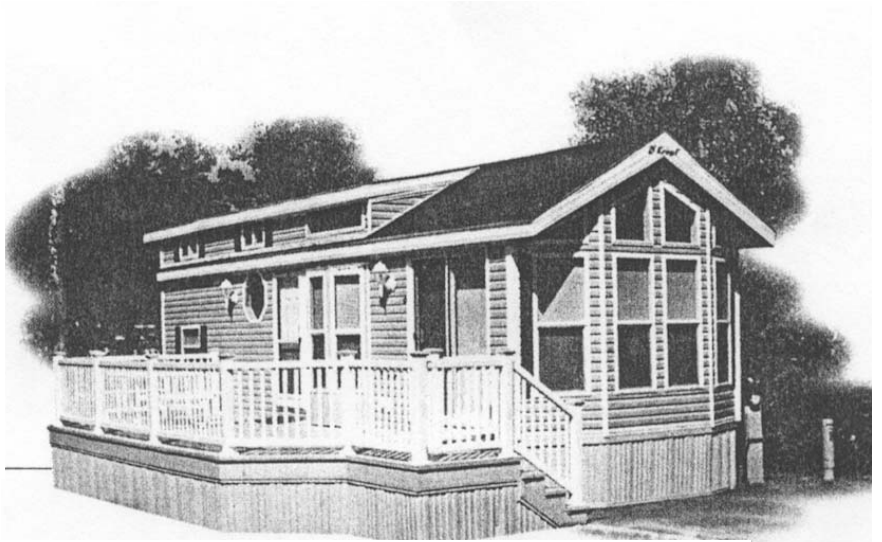
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
